In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf and after previous publication, the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following regulation to amend the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2003, namely,-

Regulations

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) This Regulation may be called the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Second Amendment Regulation, 2018.

(2) It shall come into force with effect from the date of publication of the same in the Government gazette.

2. Substitution of regulation. – In the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2003 (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations), for Regulation 9, the following regulation shall be substituted, namely,-

“9. Meetings of the Commission,- The Commission shall meet at the head office or any other place at such time as the Chairperson may direct.”

3. Omission of regulation. – In the Regulations, Regulation 12 shall be omitted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

Regulations 9 of the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2003, specifies that the Commission shall meet ordinarily twice in a month and in any case shall hold minimum one meeting in a month for

transaction of business and the gap between two meetings shall not exceed 30 days. Regulation 12 specifies that all meetings of the Commission shall ordinarily be held in Thiruvananthapuram at the office of the Commission. Section 92 of the Electricity Act, 2003, prescribes that the Commission shall meet at the head office or any other place at such time as the Chairman may direct. The Commission has decided to modify regulation 9 and 12 of the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2003 in accordance with Section 92 of the Electricity Act, 2003. Accordingly a draft of the KSERC (Conduct of Business) Second Amendment Regulations, 2018 has been published on 04.05.2018 for obtaining suggestions and objections from the general public. Now the Commission has decided to notify the said regulation as finally approved by the Commission.

This notification is intended to achieve the above purpose.
