INCLUSION OF KOLLAM IT PARK EXTENSION OF TECHNOPARK IN THE LICENCE FOR DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY

No.KSERC\II\LP-7\2008

PREAMBLE

Government of Kerala had vide G.O.(P) No. 19/99/PD dated 12th July, 1999 granted a licence to Technology Parks - Kerala for supplying electricity to various establishments within the Technopark campus at Kazhakuttom, Thiruvananthapuram, exercising the powers conferred under Section 19 of the Indian Electricity Rules 1956.

Extension of the licence area including Technopark Phase II and Phase III at Kazhakuttom was ordered by the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission vide order No.KSERC/II/LP-3/2007 dated 22nd May, 2008.

Extension of the licence area including Technopark extension at Pallipuram and nearby villages was ordered by the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission vide order No. KSERC/II/LP-5/2008 dated 2nd July, 2009.

The Chief Executive Officer of Technopark submitted an application before the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission for inclusion of Kollam IT Park, an extension of Technopark at Mulavana village in Kollam Taluk near Kundara Ceramics in the licence area for distribution of electricity.

As directed by the Kerala State Electricity Regulatory Commission, Technopark published a notice inviting objections / comments from various consumers and stake holders in English and Malayalam dailies on 9th February 2009 indicating the boundaries of the proposed area.

In the said notice it was made clear that objections if any would have to be submitted within 30 days from the date of notification.

Copy of application was forwarded to Government of Kerala and Kerala State Electricity Board on 29th November 2008 for remarks.

A Public hearing on the application was held at Elamballur Grama Panchayat Hall at Kundara on 6th June 2009.

No comments were furnished by Government of Kerala. Kerala State Electricity Board had submitted their comments vide letter dated 27th May 2009.

Thus the Commission has observed all the formalities required and has given ample opportunities to the public, Government of Kerala and Kerala State Electricity Board to raise objections if any.

The comments of the Kerala State Electricity Board was also considered by the Commission.

Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India has vide order dated 19th November 2009 notified the IT Park at Mulavana village as a Special Economic Zone.

In exercise of powers conferred under Section 14 of the Electricity Act 2003 (Central Act 36 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, Kerala Sate Electricity Regulatory Commission hereby makes the following amendments to order No. KSERC/II/LP-3/2007 Dated 22nd May 2008.

ORDER

1. Clause “3 Area of Licence” under part II shall be substituted as follows, namely:-

“3. Area of Licence - The area of licence shall include those pieces and parcels of land acquired by Technopark at Kazhakuttom of Trivandrum Taluk, Pallipuram, Veloor, Andoorkonam and Melthonnakkal villages of Trivandrum Taluk, Mulavana village in Kollam Taluk. The boundaries of the Licence area including areas under Phase I, Phase II, Technocity and Kundara IT Park shall be as follows.

Technopark Phase I area

North: By National Highway 47, 110 kV substation KSEB and Kerala University Campus.

South: By Attipra-Thrippadapuram Road

East: By University of Kerala.

West: By NH Bypass.

Technopark Phase II Area (86 Acres)

North By Kulathoor- Manvila PWD Road,

South: By Kunnukyzhy-Arasumoodu PWD Road.

East: By Survey Nos. 180 (Part),181(Part) Attipra village.

West: By Thettiyyar Canal & NH Bypass.

Technopark Phase III Area (100 Acres)

North :By Attinkuzhi Road and Technopark Phase I.

South: By Kulathoor- Manvila PWD Road.

East: By Thrippadapuram- Arasumoodu Road.

West: By Thettiyyar Canal.

Technopark Phase IV Area (460 Acres)-Technocity

North: Partly by Mangalapuram – Karamoodu Road partly by survey numbers 465,534 and 535 of Melthonakkal village, partly by survey numbers 291,292 and 293 of Veiloor village.

South: Partly by survey numbers 97,98,108 and 110 of Andoorkonam village, partly by tarred road in Andoorkonam village and CRPF Pallipuram campus.

East: Partly by tarred Mangalapuram Panchayat Road on the North Eastern periphery and survey number 520 of Melthonakal village, partly by survey numbers 21,22,23 and 36 of Andoorkonam village. Partly by Anathachira located in Andoorkonam village, partly by Thodu (Canal) flowing along the eastern periphery of survey numbers 81,82,83,84 and 109 of Andoorkonam village..

West: Partly by tarred road of Andoorkonam village and Appolo colony on the South West. Partly by survey numbers 326,329,330,333,341,344,345,346 and 347 of Veiloor village in the North West. Partly by survey numbers 500,514 and 515 of Melthonakkal village. Partly by old NH and new NH. Partly by survey numbers 294 and 295 of Veiloor village.

Technopark Phase V Area (44.5 Acres)-Kollam IT Park

North :By Elaveloor-Bharanikavu Road.

South: By Kanjiracode Lake.

East: By Kanjirakode Canal.

West: ByKerala Ceramics clay factory and Kanjirakode Lake.

2. The area under Clause 3 is excluded from the area of licence of the Kerala State Electricity Board. Technopark alone shall be the Licensee authorized to distribute electricity in this areas.

Other comments:

All other conditions of the order dated 22nd May 2008 amended by order dated 2nd July 2009 and order dated 11th August 2009 remain the same. A copy of the map showing Kollam IT Park extension is enclosed.
